TRIP ITINERARY

DAY 1

Arrive Cairo (CAI)

Upon arrival at Cairo airport and after clearing the immigration and customs, look for your name placard, here our airport representative will welcome and meet you and later, you will be transferred to the hotel.

Rest of the day is yours at Leisure.

| #Pace of Travel: Moderate #Steps to Walk: Approximately 2,000 (Airport to transfer areas and hotel facilities) #Facilities: Airport assistance, hotel check-in services, leisure facilities at the hotel.

#Age: Suitable for all ages.

#What to Bring: Passport, travel documents, comfortable clothing, and essentials for leisure time.

#What to Do: Relax at the hotel, explore the surroundings at your leisure.

#What Not to Do: Avoid strenuous activities or long outdoor walks after your flight.

#Tip for You: Hydrate well after the flight; familiarize yourself with the hotel's amenities.

#Overnight: Cairo #Transfer: Airport to hotel transfer in a comfortable AC car.

DAY 2

Cairo - City Tour

Breakfast at the hotel.

Today, start the tour with a visit to Egyptian Museum at downtown, which is one of the world's most important collections of ancient artifacts.

To walk around the museum is to embark on an adventure through time.

Also, visit citadel and Mohammed Ali mosque.

Citadel is a medieval Islamic fortification located on Mokattam Hill in the center of Cairo.

The Mosque of Muhammad Ali in the center of the Citadel is a grandiose Ottoman structure, constructed during the early 19th century.

Before returning back to the hotel, visit Khan el-Khalili Bazaar for about an hour.

| #Pace of Travel: Moderate #Steps to Walk: Approximately 8,000 (museum, mosque, bazaar exploration) #Facilities: Breakfast, transport for sightseeing, and guide services.

#Age: 10 years and above (due to walking and historical focus).

#What to Bring: Comfortable shoes, water, sun protection, and a camera.

#What to Do: Marvel at ancient artifacts at the Egyptian Museum, explore the Citadel and Muhammad Ali Mosque, and shop at Khan el-Khalili Bazaar.

#What Not to Do: Avoid purchasing items without negotiating at the bazaar.

#Tips for Travelers: Carry small bills for tips or purchases; keep hydrated during the day.

#Note: When visiting a mosque, it is important to follow certain dress etiquette to show respect for the sacred space: #Modest Clothing: Both men and women should wear modest, loose-fitting clothing that covers the body.

Avoid tight, short, or revealing clothes.

#Women's Dress Code: Women are typically required to cover their hair with a scarf or shawl.

They should also wear long sleeves and skirts or pants that cover their legs, ideally reaching the ankles.

#Men's Dress Code: Men should avoid wearing shorts.

Long pants and a shirt with sleeves (either short or long) are appropriate.

#Footwear: Shoes must be removed before entering the mosque.

It is advised to wear clean socks or bring slip-on shoes to make the process easier.

Respectful and Clean Appearance: Ensure your clothing is clean and neat, as a sign of respect for the place of worship.

#Overnight: Cairo #Meal: Breakfast and Dinner #Transfer: Transportation provided

DAY 3

Cairo - Pyramid Tour

Breakfast at the hotel.

Full-day excursion to visit Pyramids of Giza.

One of the Seven Wonders of the World including the visit of the sphinx.

The great pyramids of Giza are massive monuments that were unsurpassed in height for thousands of years after their construction and continue to amaze and enthrall us with their overwhelming mass and seemingly impossible perfection.

In the evening, transfer to hotel.

DAY 7

Soak up beautiful city views on an 'Abra Water Taxi' across Dubai creek; browse the bustling Gold and Spice Souks, and take snapshots of the Jumeirah Mosque whose domes and minarets echo the medieval Fatimid style.

Plus, stop to see one of Dubai's greatest icons, the sail-shaped Burj Al Arab hotel.

After sightseeing transfer to the hotel.

Later at 1930 hrs.

, pick in the evening for Dinner Dhow Cruise.

A visit to Dubai is incomplete without a cruise along the Dubai Marina in a traditional wooden Dhow. The traditional dhow glides silently through the water and the tour offers an intriguing different view of this beautifully lit city.

Admire the architecture of places such as the National Bank of Dubai and the spectacular Chamber of Commerce building.

Enjoy the traditional Abra ride for an authentic experience of Dubai Creek.

#Overnight: Dubai Hotel #Meal: Breakfast #Transfers: Round-trip hotel to city tour locations.

DAY 8

Dubai Desert Safari with Dinner

Around 1500 hrs.

pick up for DESERT SAFARI WITH BBQ DINNER.

Your tour begins with an unforgettable roller coaster drive in the desert skimming over the magnificent Sand Dunes.

After which we will proceed, towards our camp with a stop en route to experience a memorable desert sunset.

A traditional welcome awaits our guests with Arabic coffee, tea, and dates while the charcoal fires and the traditional oven is lit in preparation for our evening dinner.

Take some time out to relax in the Arabic tents furnished with carpets and pillows for your comfort or chill out by the campfire.

Get a henna tattoo or experience an unforgettable camel ride while we wait for the highlight of the evening which includes a Tannoura dance show and an exotic belly performance to the rhythmic beat of Arabia.

#Age: Suitable for 10 years and above; dune bashing may not be ideal for elderly or very young children.

#What to Bring: Sunglasses, sunscreen, a hat, cameras, and comfortable clothing.

#What to Do: Use sunscreen and hydrate well before the safari and secure loose items during dune bashing.

#What Not to Do: Don't skip the evening performances or hesitate to try the Arabic coffee and dates.

#Tip for You: Avoid heavy meals before the safari to prevent motion sickness during dune bashing.

#Overnight: Dubai Hotel #Meals Included: Breakfast and BBQ Dinner #Transfers: Round-trip hotel to desert camp transfer.

After breakfast, the day is free at leisure.

Optional Tour - In the afternoon, we will proceed 'At the Top' of Burj Khalifa (at additional cost)'.

Ride the 213-foot (65-meter) moving sidewalk and as you travel, watch a multimedia presentation that tells the story of Dubai and the building of the Burj Khalifa.

Glimpse views of the tower at the end of the sidewalk before stepping inside the elevator, soaring 33 feet (10 meters) every second to the 124th-floor observation point.

As the elevator opens, walk the perimeter of the full-height, wrap-round glass walls.

Take in the astonishing panoramas that stretch across the Palm Jumeirah, sail-shaped Burj Al-Arab, the gleaming yachts of Dubai Marina, the desert, and the Persian Gulf.

If you've chosen to visit in the evening, then you will admire the illuminated skyline of Dubai stretched below.

Hone in on particular landmarks with the state-of-the-art telescopes and view the virtual snapshots that take you through history.

If the weather allows, visit the outdoor terrace to experience the positive energy of the open views.

And before you leave, buy some Burj Khalifa mementos (own expense) at the gift store.

Most visitors feel that an hour to 90 minutes is sufficient to fully appreciate the views, but feel free to stay longer, the ticket lets you spend as long as you wish at 'At the Top'.

Your experience ends when you ride the elevator back down the tower and then leave for Dubai Mall.

After breakfast, transfer to the airport to board the onward flight.

#Tips for You: Arrive at the airport at least 3 hours before departure.

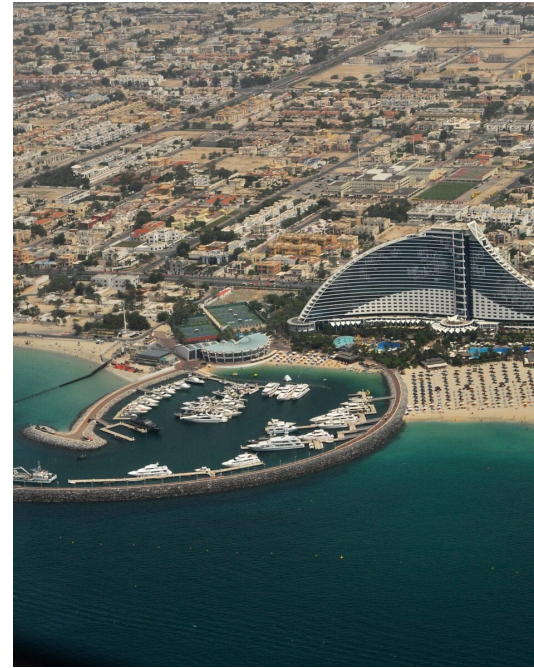

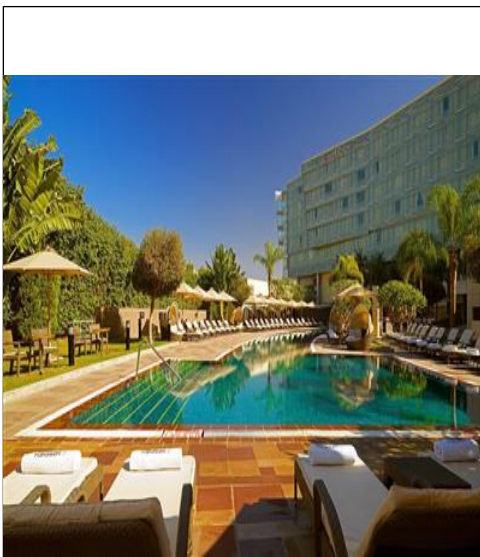
